OPEN GARDENS WEEK-END - 29th and 30th JUNE 2019

Some of you may be aware that this year those who organise the Open Gardens weekend have decided that there are to be changes. The Open Gardens weekend was set up to benefit the church by a group of friends 27 years ago and soon became the main fundraiser for the church and still is today.

A few years ago in PCC it was agreed that rather than the proceeds going to the general running costs, the Open Gardens proceeds should go to a specific project at church and it was decided to conserve the Alabaster Arch at the West Door. This project has proved a costly one but one which has conserved the Arch for many, many years to come. There are plans on hold at the moment for the "Easy Access for All", as the lighting project has taken preference because it is becoming increasingly necessary to replace the old system.

Sadly, representatives from the church have not been invited to attend the planning meetings and the organising group has decided without consultation with the church council that this year the church will only receive half of the proceeds, the remainder going to different causes, yet to be decided. This will have a devastating effect on the plans already in place.

The Priory Church of St. Mary has always been the umbrella organisation for Open Gardens (it was set up for this purpose). It now appears that the Civic Society will become the "umbrella" in the future, which leaves those in the church trying to come to terms with how funds for existing planned projects (decided upon in conjunction with the Open Gardens group) will be met.

The church of course will be open to welcome visitors over the weekend and will be more than happy to show people the Conserved Arch.

We are very grateful for all that has been achieved for the church in the past but saddened that this decision has been made as it will impact greatly on the way in which this beautiful and unique building can be kept in the excellent order it is in today. We rely solely on donations from individuals and groups and grants for specific projects but the church does not received financial support from the Diocese or other official bodies etc. etc.

A church has stood on this site for 930 years this year and most people in Tutbury are proud to have such a beautiful building whether they use it for worship, private prayer, a family celebration or just a cup of coffee – everyone is welcome – but it does come with a considerable cost!
