TUTBURY DAY – CELEBRATING 930 year of WORSHIP

Our Patronal Festival falls on Thursday, 15th August 2019 and in celebration the church will be open over the week-end, Saturday 17th and Sunday 18th, so people can come and join us. Various things are in the planning stage and as soon as confirmed we will let you know.

HELP KEEP THE LIGHTS ON!

The Diocese has now approved the Parochial Church Council's proposals to install new lighting in the nave and chancel. Work should start on 19th August and be finished by the end of the month. The PCC is aware that people have had difficulty in reading hymn books and prayer books and hope that the new lighting will bring a great improvement. A dimming facility is being included so that lights can be dimmed as and when required, or when just a section of the church needs to be lit. Running costs should be a lot lower as the new fittings will be LED rather than the existing halogen.

The cost is estimated at £31,291 and at present we have approximately £7,500 towards this consisting funds from the Friends of St. Mary's, Burton Consolidated Charities and other personal donations. The remainder will have to be funded from investments but grants are still being sought. VAT of around £5,215 should be able to be reclaimed, but this will leave a net figure of approximately £26,000 to be found.
