ANNUAL PAROCIAL CHURCH MEETINGS

Statement of Accounts

This will be discussed at the meeting - as we are all aware this has been a difficult year for the church finances.

The Income to date is: £34305.36

The Expenditure to date is: £33894.58 **Balance £410.78**

Lichfield Diocesan Board of Finance has granted a month and a half holiday from paying the Parish Share, which equates to £3000.00. We have only been able to pay half our share, a £1000.00 per month from the

end of March but in September we were able to pay an extra £1500.00.

To date our arrears to the Diocese total £4500.00, to complete payment of our Parish Share by the end of this year.

We have paid all other bills but testing times are ahead when we have to heat the church.

FUND RAISING

Janice Sherratt, has been making cakes for people during Lock-Down, the proceeds from which are for the church.

Her cakes were very much appreciated during Open Gardens week-end, so she has decided to carry on, so if you would like a home-made fruit cake, apple pie etc. etc. she usually charges £5.00. Please contact Janice on 01283 814546. Again proceeds to church funds.

TODAY'S READINGS AND REFLECTION PROMPTS

1 Thessalonians 1 v 1-10

1 Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy,

To the church of the Thessalonians in God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ:

Grace to you and peace.

²We always give thanks to God for all of you and mention you in our prayers, constantly ³remembering before our God and Father your work of faith and labour of love and steadfastness of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ. ⁴For we know, brothers and sisters beloved by God, that he has chosen you, ⁵because our message of the gospel came to you not in word only, but also in power and in the Holy Spirit and with full conviction; just as you know what kind of persons we proved to be among you for your sake. ⁶And you became imitators of us and of the Lord, for in spite of persecution you received the word with joy inspired by the Holy Spirit, ⁷so that you became an example to all the believers in Macedonia and in Achaia. ⁸For the word of the Lord has sounded forth from you not only in Macedonia and Achaia, but in every place your faith in God has become known, so that we have no need to speak about it. ⁹For the people of those regions report about us what kind of welcome we had among you, and how you turned to God from idols, to serve a living and true God, ¹⁰and to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead - Jesus, who rescues us from the wrath that is coming.

Matthew 22 v 15 – 22. The Question about Paying Taxes

¹⁵Then the Pharisees went and plotted to entrap him in what he said. ¹⁶So they sent their disciples to him, along with the Herodians, saying, "Teacher, we know that you are sincere, and teach the way of God in accordance with truth, and show deference to no one; for you do not regard people with partiality. ¹⁷Tell us, then, what you think. Is it lawful to pay taxes to the emperor, or not?" ¹⁸But Jesus, aware of their malice, said, "Why are you putting me to the test, you hypocrites? ¹⁹Show me the coin used for the tax." And they brought him a denarius. ²⁰Then Jesus said to them, "Whose head is this, and whose title?" ²¹They answered, "Caesar's, the emperor" Then he said to them, "Give therefore to Caesar the things that are Caesars' and to God the things that are God's."

²² When they heard this, they were amazed; and they left him and went away.

These can be used instead of a sermon in church, either in silence or in small groups.

Example 1:

What is God saying from this Bible passage to me / to these people today?

Example 2:

- a. What does this bible passage say?
- b. What does this passage mean?
- c. How does it apply to me / us today?

Example 3:

- a. The context of our reading(s)?
- b. What phrases or words are key and/or stand out to us?
- c. If this is the word of the Lord, which is meant to change our lives, how will our lives change in the next few days (or weeks) from having heard it?
